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- 7: NO chalk or earth shall be dug beyond what is necessary for the purposes of excavating for foundation or approaches or for use in the construction of the buildings.
- 8: THE Purchaser shall not obstruct the said roads or any of them nor remove nor disturb the soil or surface thereof except so far as may be necessary for the purpose of laying (for which ourpose 24 hours notice in writing shall be given by the Purchaser) drain pipes from the property purchased by him to the sewer in the roadway and the disturbance of the roadway shall as soon as possible be made good at the expense of the Purchaser:
